- Attend staff meetings, in-services, open houses, parent conferences, and other activities.
- Display the highest ethical and professional behavior, standards and judgment.
- Maintain positive, cooperative, and mutually supportive relationships when working with students, parents, school personnel and agencies associated with the school.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Hold a certificate or be in the process of acquiring a subject area endorsement.
- Experience working with inner city youth in a middle school.
